

Professional & Staff Services

Basic Professional Fees \$660.00

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, which may include, but is not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs, including essential services relating to disposition, drafting notices, planning scheduling of services, advising with regards to possible government benefits. (Requires Basic Facility Charge for Traditional or Memorial Services)

Co-ordinating Rites and Ceremonies \$885.00

Co-ordination of all rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as flowers and death notices, audio/visual and pianist/organist.

<u>Documentation- Permits and Forms \$300.00</u>

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation or documentation necessary to ship the body out of country. As part of this service, we will provide you with 12 Funeral Directors' Certificates of Death; such certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes in the Province of Ontario, but sometimes an Official Provincial "Certified Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General.

Basic Preparation of Remains \$150.00

The preparation of the body for placement into the casket, including bathing, dressing and the setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming. (Requires facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter). An additional charge of \$125.00 (for up to 3 days) will apply for refrigeration, for those families who have declined embalming. All deceased that are not embalmed, are placed in a refrigeration cooler to help slow down the process of decomposition and helps permit identification to occur. An additional charge of \$95.00 will apply for implanted devices removal, for those who selected cremation. One example would be a pacemaker.

Environmental Service \$25.00

A charge for biohazardous materials and disposal costs will be applied in most circumstances. Stericycle is a compliance company that specializes in collecting and disposing regulated substances, such as medical waste and sharps.

Embalming of Remains \$500.00

Embalming is the process of replacing the blood and bodily fluids with a chemical preservative. It is the process of sanitation, restoration, and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but is recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation, service, or disposition of the deceased. There is an additional charge of \$175.00 for all autopsies. Restorative work is charge at \$80 per hour.

Refrigeration \$150.00

For those families who have declined embalming. All deceased are placed in our refrigeration cooler. The refrigeration helps to slow down the process of decomposition and helps permit identification/time of reflection. Use of the cooler is up to 3 days or part there-of.



Staff Services for Visitation – Requires Facilities for Visitation \$250.00

Staff to co-ordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering) at our premises for 1 day visitation (2-4 & 7-9pm) or part there-of. Staff to co-ordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering) at our premises where visitation is limited to 1 hour prior to the service, fee is reduced to \$100.00 (Combined with the facility for visitation reduction, a total allowance of \$250.00 will apply).

Offsite Visitation \$250/per hour

If the visitation takes place at an offsite location, the full \$250.00 will be deducted and a flat rate fee of \$250.00/hr will apply from the time we leave the funeral home until the services that day have ended. An equipment charge of \$75/day will apply for any offsite visitation/services.

Staff Services for Ceremony – Requires Facilities for Ceremony \$300.00

At least one licensed funeral director and assistants to coordinate and oversee the ceremony in our chapel. Includes setting up the room/area (floral arrangements, pictures, memorabilia, casket/urn, cleaning and sanitizing), greeting and directing visitors, supervision of parking.

Offsite Service \$250/per hour

If the ceremony takes place at an offsite location, the full \$300.00 will be deducted and a flat rate fee of \$250.00/hr will apply from the time we leave the funeral home until the services that day have ended. An equipment charge of \$75/day will apply for any offsite visitation/services.

Facility Charges

Basic Facilities – Requires Basic Professional Charge \$5

Use of our general and common areas, parking lot, public washrooms, cloakrooms, heating, lighting, and maintenance. This charge applies whenever we provide services to you.

Facilities for Preparation/Embalming/Shelter \$150.00

A secure and private room used to prepare, embalm, and/or shelter the body until the time of burial, cremation, or alternative disposition. This charge applies whenever the body is in our facility.

Facilities for Visitation – Requires Staff Services for Visitation \$275.00

Designated facilities used for visitation for 1 day visitation (2-4 & 7-9pm) or part there-of. If visitation is limited to 1 hour prior to the service, fee is reduced to \$175.00. (Combined with the staff for visitation reduction, a total allowance of \$275.00 will apply). **Offsite Visitation:** will be deducted if visitation is not at our facility.

Facilities for Ceremony – Requires Staff Services for Ceremony \$275.00

Use of designated facilities for the funeral service (body/casket is present) or memorial service (urn/cremated remains may <u>or</u> may not be present). This fee is separate from Facilities for visitation, even if the visitation was immediately before and in the same room. **Offsite Ceremony:** will be deducted if ceremony is not at our facility.



Vehicles

Initial Transportation of Remains \$250.00

Vehicle, trained staff and specialized equipment used to transfer remains into our care from the place of death. This price is based on a local transfer within 25 kilometers. Extra staff required \$175.00 per person from 9am - 5pm. Extra staff required \$250.00 per person from 5pm - 9am. An additional charge of \$1.45 per kilometer is applied for any vehicle that travels more than 25 kilometers both ways.

Administration/Lead/Clergy Vehicle \$125.00

Used to register death, obtain documents, pick up the clergy if required and/or transport the staff and/or clergy to the location of the service and/or cemetery.

Flower/Transportation/Equipment Vehicle \$125.00

Used to distribute flowers after the service, general transportation for staff to service offsite location, memorabilia, and equipment.

<u>Limousine</u> \$ At Cost

Used to transport family from funeral home/church to cemetery and back.

Final Transfer of Remains

Vehicle and staff to transfer the deceased to the final place of disposition

Funeral Van \$250.00 Funeral Coach \$600.00

An additional charge of \$1.45 per kilometer is applied for any vehicle that travels more than 25 kilometers both ways.

Other Available Services, Supplies and Equipment

Additional Facilities for Visitation (Extra Day) \$275.00

Designated facilities used for visitation (informal gathering) for 1 day visitation (2-4 & 7-9pm) or part there-of which exceeds the basic period selected. A flat fee will apply for each additional day.

Additional Staff for Visitation (Extra Day) \$250.00

Staff to oversee visitation (informal gathering) for 1 day visitation (2-4 & 7-9pm) or part there-of which exceeds the basic period selected. A flat fee will apply for each additional day.

Staff Services Offsite \$250/per hour

If either the visitation or the ceremony takes place at an offsite location, the corresponding staff and facility charges will be deducted from the general services fees. An offsite staff service charge will apply from the time we leave the funeral home and continue an hourly basis until the services that day are ended. An equipment charge of \$75/day will apply for any offsite visitation/services.

Stand By Time \$200.00

Time spent holding vehicles and staff available when the final disposition of the deceased does not immediately follow the ceremony.



Equipment \$75.00

Equipment required for offsite services, applies per day.

Statutory Holidays, Sundays, Evening Service/Visitation Surcharge \$500.00

At the funeral home, evening/Sunday Surcharges may be applicable for a ceremony being held outside of normal business hours (9am - 5pm Monday to Saturday), due to the need to coordinate additional staff to accommodate your request. These items are listed as:

- Evening Service Surcharge (after 4pm)
- Sunday/Statutory Holiday Service Surcharge
- Statutory Holiday Visitation Surcharge

<u>Time of Reflection (Private Family Viewing)</u> \$150.00

Time of Reflection will take place at a time that is convenient for Funeral Home and the family, within 24 hours of the arrangement conference. The Time of Reflection will take place in the family viewing room or visitation room. The Time of Reflection is limited to 30 minutes and may be attended by immediate family members. Prior to the Time of Reflection, the mouth and eyes of the deceased will be closed. A disinfectant cleansing of the face and other areas of the body is applied as deemed necessary by the Funeral Director. For individuals who have undergone an autopsy, additional procedure may be required for viewing to take place. There may be an additional charge depending on the work required.

Staff Services for Private Family Viewing \$75.00

Staff to coordinate and oversee the Private Family Viewing for 30 minutes.

Facilities for Private Family Viewing _____\$ 75.00

Use of a designated room for the Private Family Viewing for 30 minutes.

Reception Centre \$600.00

Use of facilities for a reception following the ceremony which includes the set up of the facilities, the use of the facilities and the amenities. Use of the reception facilities is for a period of 3 hours (½ hour set up, 2 hours for reception, ½ hour cleanup), after the 3 hours an additional charge of \$75.00/hr or part there-of will apply. We offer a variety of menus to choose from. Coffee, tea, dishware, cutlery, and use of the kitchen are included. Serving of alcohol requires a Special Occasions Permit obtained from the LCBO and the hiring of a Smart-Server. Catering Services to be paid by A. Millard George direct to the Chef's Hat Catering. All food is extra and there are many options to select from.

<u>Winter Storage, Spring Burials, Prolong Storage – Refrigeration</u> \$250 per month Storage of the deceased per month or part there-of in our refrigeration cooler, embalming required.



Compassion Suite – MAID Procedure

This suite was designed for those choosing Medical Assistance In Dying (MAID). The room is set-up for family, close friends, and the participant to have a comfortable setting for their final gathering. The room has a living room, medical bed, and a fully electric recliner chair. The room can be rented for a minimum of 4 hours with a set time for MAID to take place during this time frame. The MAID program is offered from 9am – 5pm each day, excluding Statutory Holidays. Only one MAID procedure per day is permitted. The Compassion Suite has two available spots for MAID to take place: the medical bed or the recliner chair. If your family is using a different Funeral Home or Transfer Service provider to look after your loved one after the MAID procedure. The fee is \$725.00. Further information provided in Compassion Suite Procedure.

Deposit for Cremated Remains \$300.00

When human remains are to be cremated, a deposit may be required if the cremated remains are not taken home or interred immediately. If they are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground at a cemetery of our choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, a pro-rated portion (\$25.00/month or part there-of) will be refunded.

Hairdressing \$85.00

Use of a professional hairdresser. Base Price, hair cuts, dying extra.

Removal of Implanted Device \$95.00

This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a body that has a pacemaker or other implant and must be carried out by a licensed funeral director. Includes disposal of device. (i.e. pacemaker) (If an outside service is required, additional fees may be incurred).

Pallbearers \$115.00 per pallbearer

Pallbearers are supplied when pallbearers are unable to act. Mileage and extra fees may apply for outside the city.

Cremation fee: This fee is charged by the crematorium for the cremation of the body. The fee varies by crematorium. Please be advised we are part owners of Southwest Crematoriums and as such you are not obligated to use this crematorium. This disbursement is subject to H.S.T.	\$ Varies
Coroner's fee: This is a provincially set fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation/alternative disposition or 'Out of Province' shipping to take place. This disbursement is not subject to H.S.T	\$75



Interment fee: This fee is charged by the cemetery for the opening and closing of the grave. The fee varies by cemetery and by the size and depth of the grave. Bill directly to the family or executor/administrator.	\$ Varies
Municipal death registration fee: This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay. This disbursement is not subject to H.S.T.	\$ 40.00
Municipal death registration fee for deaths outside the city This disbursement is not subject to H.S.T.	\$75.00
Bereavement Authority of Ontario Consumer Protection Fee: This fee is to provide its services of information on your options in bereavement services and to regulate the profession making sure the law is consistently followed. CASKETS

The following caskets listed are those generally available. Additional options are available upon request. Unless otherwise noted, all caskets listed are standard adult size.

Minimum requirements for a casket:

<u>For burial</u>: The least expensive wood casket is suitable and is required by most cemeteries' bylaws for interment, in the interest of the health and safety of the workers involved in the interment process. A metal casket may also be used for burial. A growing number of cemeteries in Ontario offer "green" burials, which may consist of interment of a body without a casket. Since there is no legal definition for a "green" burial, it varies from one cemetery to another. For more information, please speak with one of our funeral directors, or visit www.greenburialcanada.ca.

<u>For cremation</u>: A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak-proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fibre-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation. We offer a selection of inexpensive caskets below that are suitable for cremation.



HISTORY

In 1935, Mr. Alfred Millard George opened London Funeral Service at 104 Dundas Street, London. The business later moved to 339 King Street, London, where the firm operated as Irving and George Funeral Home.

After purchasing the property at 190 Wortley Road, London, Mr. George established the **A. Millard George Funeral Home**, which operated from 1940 - 1968 in this location. In 1957, Mr. George purchased the Ardaven Funeral Chapel at 60 Ridout Street South, London, and in 1965, built a new funeral home on this site. The A. Millard George Funeral Home Limited was dedicated on February 11, 1965.

Paul J. Mullen began his apprenticeship under Mr. George in 1965 and the two become partners in 1971. Paul J. Mullen became the sole owner upon Mr. George's death in 1993.

Paul's son, David Mullen, became a Licensed Funeral Director in 1998. In 2006, David became partners with his father, ensuring that the A. Millard George Funeral Home (AMG) would remain family owned and operated. In June 2015, Paul retired after 48 years in the business and passed ownership to David. Paul J. Mullen died on Saturday, December 12, 2020, in his 77th year.
